





- Survey Results
 - 24 out of 95 orgs responded
 - Comprise approximately 1250 active members
 - 118 outreach events and 32 community service programs annually,
 with 8300 K-12 students reached at outreach events alone
 - 27 conferences and 36 competitions attended
 - Clubs who use facilities utilize Boyd Lab with 480 machining hours
 - 15 out of 24 inhabit physical space on campus

- •All remarks must be directed toward the chair
- •No member can speak twice until all members who want to have had their turn
- Debate can not begin until the chair has stated the motion
- Must be recognized by chair before speaking
